Gently slide the swab 2 inches (5 cm) into the vagina. If the swab does not slide easily, gently rotate the swab as you push. If it is still difficult, do not attempt to continue self-collection; consult your clinician at this point.

Rotate the swab for 10 to 15 seconds.



Tightly re-cap the tube.



Using the BD MAX UVE Sample Buffer tube that also came with the swab, fully insert the swab into the tube so that the tip is at the bottom.

Carefully break the shaft at the score mark. Be careful to avoid splashing.

• 48 hours prior to collecting sample: Complete short-term prescribed medication eq. antibiotics.

• 24 hours prior to collecting sample: No sexual intercourse.

Do not apply vaginal lotions, creams, or emollients before taking the test. Do not wash your genital area prior to collection.



Carefully and slowly insert the swab into the vagina until your fingers touch the vulva, gently rotate the swab 4 times before removing. If you experience any resistance, re-position yourself and attempt to re-insert the swab. NOTE: If you experience any unexpected bleeding, consult your healthcare practitioner immediately.

Remove the swab and place into the ESwab Transport system container.



Insert the swab until the pre-molded break point line meets the entry point of the collection vial and snap the swab. (Refer to image for guidance)



Only the swab should be provided (discard the handle portion of the swab above the indentation line after snapped off).

DO NOT CUT OR TOUCH THE END OF THE SWAB. Seal the ESwab Transport system container tightly.



Write your name, age/date of birth and time of collection on the vial where required.

Place the completed ESwab vial to the side and proceed to the second swab (BD MAX Specimen Collection Swab) and instructions below.

PART TWO - to be completed using the BD MAX specimen collection swab

2.1 Wash your hands thoroughly prior to commening test.



Twist the cap to break the seal (Figure 1). Do not use if seal is broken or damaged. Carefully pull the cap with attached swab off the tube. Do not touch the soft tip or lay the swab down. If you touch or drop the swab tip or the swab is laid down, discard the swab and request a new vaginal swab. Check for presence of the swab tip. If the swab has no tip, discard it and request a new vaginal swab.



Hold the swab by the cap with one hand so the swab tip is pointing toward you. With your other hand, gently spread the skin outside the vagina. Insert the tip of the swab into the vaginal opening. Point the tip toward your lower back and relax your muscles.

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
